Where can I park my car?

There are four car parks located around the Greenway. These are situated at:

- **Radwell Meadows** – *off Nortonbury Lane*
- **Manor Wood**
- **Wymondley Wood** – *off Wymondley Road*
- **Standalone Farm** – *disabled parking is also available*

How accessible is the route?

Various stretches of the Garden City Greenway are suitable for wheelchairs and people with reduced mobility.

Are there any picnic areas or places to eat?

There are picnic areas at Radwell Meadows and Manor Wood. There are also benches along the route. Please ensure you take your rubbish home. The Greenway Café at Standalone Farm offers a range of hot and cold food, snacks and drinks.

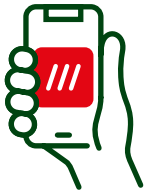

- **Plan ahead** – check the weather and know your route.
- **Ensure your phone is fully charged.**

Consider downloading the **What3Words app** as a way of sending your precise location in case of emergency.



The Countryside Code



Respect everyone

- Be considerate to those living in, working in and enjoying the countryside
- Leave gates and property as you find them
- Do not block access to gateways or driveways when parking
- Be nice, say hello, share the space – remember some people might be moving in different directions at different speeds
- Follow local signs and keep to marked paths

Protect the environment

- Take your litter home – leave no trace of your visit
- Do not light fires
- Always keep dogs under control and in sight – and on leads when around livestock
- Dog poo – bag it and bin it in any public waste bin or take it home
- Care for nature – do not cause damage or disturbance

- Check your route and local conditions
- Plan your adventure – know what to expect and what you can do
- Enjoy your visit, have fun, make a memory

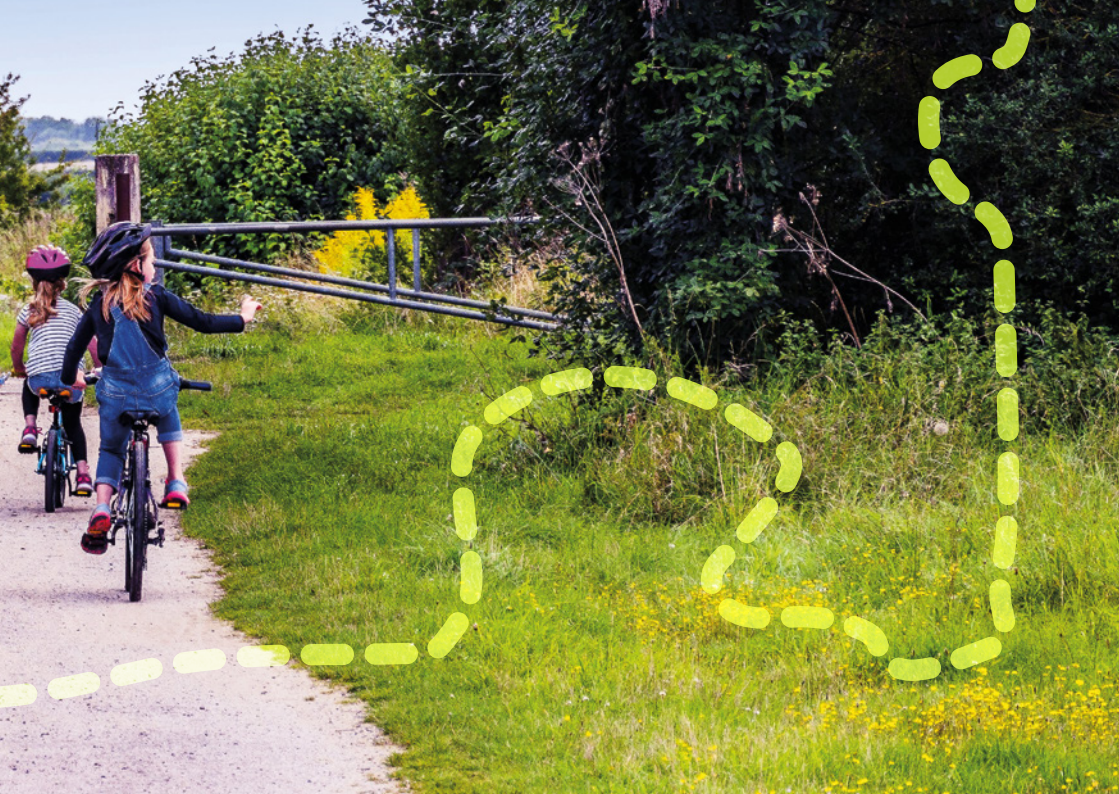
