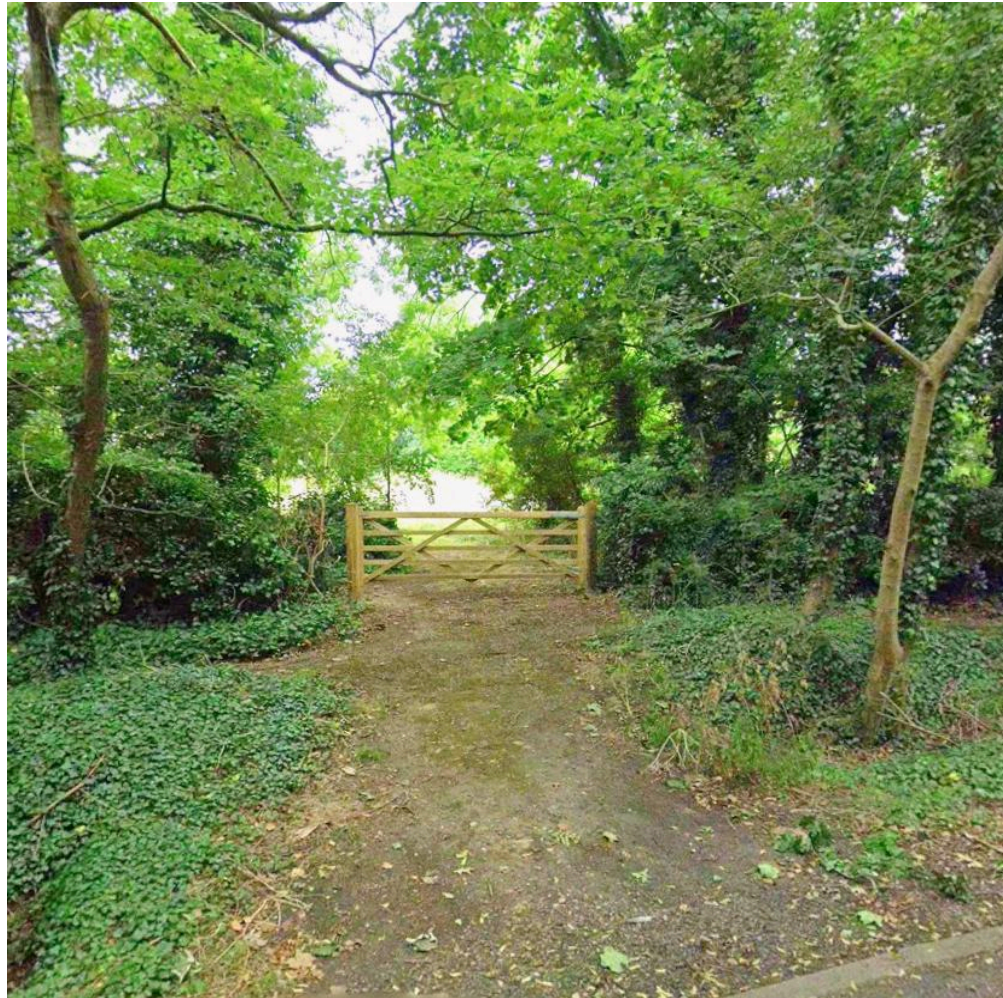




I am going to Play! Discover! Share! *Goes Wild* at Spring Road Spinney in Letchworth.

It is OK if I do not want to join in or talk to others. I can sit in the Quiet Zone for as long as I like.





I can use the sensory bag. It will be hanging up in the Quiet Zone. It has ear defenders and other items like a squishy ball, fidget tangle, sunglasses, a cuddly squirrel and a spikey ball for me to use.





At the information tent or walking around the field I might meet Becky and Emma. They are looking after all the activities and visitors. They will be wearing Letchworth t-shirts and name badges. They are friendly and can help me if I need it.
